



Tips for Being a Great Crew Leader

1. Work together as a team.
 - a. Have the older children help the younger children.
 - b. If you have younger children, make sure to hold hands as you go from station to station.
 - c. Work with your partner to share the responsibilities.
 - d. Make sure you help your crew be successful whether it is at Awesome Art, Games Gym, Super Science, Maker Station, SongFest or Bible Adventures!

2. Be a role model. Kids will follow your lead.
 - a. Listen to the directions at each of the stations.
 - b. Participate in the activities.
 - c. Be enthusiastic!
 - d. Participate in the God Sightings.

3. Make everyone feel welcome.
 - a. Get to know the children's names as quickly as you can.
 - b. Smile as they come in each morning; say hi to their parents when they drop them off and pick them up.
 - c. Make sure you pay attention to each of your crew members.
 - d. Give them compliments when you see them doing good things.
 - e. Be on time so that you are waiting for them to arrive, not the other way around!

4. Help reinforce the lessons each day.
 - a. Sit in circles during discussions so everyone can hear and see each other.
 - b. Invite everyone to offer their opinion.
 - c. Use open-ended questions – ones that don't have a "right" or a "wrong" answer. (Like, "How did you feel about...")
 - d. Ask follow-up questions to draw out shy students like "Tell me more," "What did you mean by that?"
