

Trunk or Treat Instructions

Join in and shine the light of Jesus in the lives of kids and families of our community. Trunk or Treat is a fun, safe alternative to nighttime trick or treating, as it occurs in daylight hours. It is an opportunity for Calvary to interact with our community. You have been invited to decorate the trunk of your car, golf cart, truck bed or the back of your SUVs and hand out candy and other goodies to the children of Solana Beach who may or may not be dressed in there spookiest or silliest Halloween costumes. They will walk from trunk to trunk to for treats that are given away and to see your display! This year Calvary's Trunk or Treat is Saturday, October 30 from 4:30 p.m. - 5:30 p.m. in the upper parking lot of Calvary. GUIDELINES:

- Participating vehicles should arrive in Calvary's upper parking lot for check-in between than 3:30 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.
- Vehicles will be parked in order of arrival and be separated by 1 parking stall.
- All participating trunks must be decorated and staffed by 4:15 p.m.
- Vehicles arriving after 4:00 p.m. will not be allowed to participate for safety reasons.
- Trunk-or-treating begins at 4:30 p.m. To ensure safety, participating vehicles must remain parked until the event ends, and the participants have vacated the area (by approximately 5:45pm.)
- Electricity will not be available for decorating your vehicle.
- Restrooms will be available outside the Fellowship Hall
- The Trunk or Treat event is family friendly. We encourage non-ghoulish decorations and costumes. Please refrain from any major gory items.
- Participating vehicles must be prepared to provide store-bought wrapped candy for children.
- Trunk or Treat is an alcohol-free event.
- Not interested in decorating your car but want to join us and hand out candy? Great! Bring your candy and beach chairs and we'll park you between the cars.
- We are committed to our COVID protocols therefore participants must commit to keeping socially distant by 6 feet. Participants are encouraged to create a no-touch delivery using tongs, grabbers or a gutter etc.
- Participants are encouraged to smile, engage in conversation, and be interested in the children and families that visit your trunk.
- A \$25 gift card will be awarded to the following categories: Most Creative, Best Biblical Theme, Most Silly Display.
