

Items for Clothing Drive for Showers of Blessings

WOMEN

- Sports bras, preferably white (new) 10 size medium, 10 size large, 10 size XL
- Cotton lined underpants (new; no bikini or thongs please): 10 pair size small, 10 pair size medium, 10 pair size large
- White Crew Socks (new) 10 pair size medium, 10 pair large
- Outerwear: Sweaters, Windbreakers, Jackets any style, size and may be gently used.
- Solid walking shoes or sneakers: any size appreciated; gently used fine

MEN

- White cotton undershirts or tee shirts with sleeves 40 each size 34, 36, 38
- Cotton briefs (new) 20 pair each size 34, 36, 38
- Heavy duty long-legged pants or jeans, or athletic pants: any size, gently used
- Solid walking shoes or sneakers, gently used, any size appreciated



Volunteer Opportunities at Showers of Blessing on Saturdays

The following is a list of volunteer opportunities available every Saturday. Signups are available on sign-up genius at [NCSOB St. Andrew's Encinitas: Showers of Blessings \(signupgenius.com\)](https://signupgenius.com)

1. Intake table – Sign-In
Signs up guests for services; completes and hands out numbered nametags, clothing tickets and towels. Begin sign in at 8 AM.
2. Intake Table-Checkin and Traffic Control
Reviews code of conduct with guests and obtained signed waivers from new guests. Encourages unvaccinated people to use masks and social distancing. Maintains legible roster and assists other intake volunteer. Begins check-in at 8 AM
3. Shower cleaners
Clean and disinfect shower unit between users. Follow CDC guidelines for sanitizing and uses face shields gloves and PPE. Controls timing of showers.
4. Clothing distribution.
Volunteers distribute change of clothes, underwear and socks to shower guests on “as available and as needed” quota basis. Sorts, sizes, labels and stores donated clothing in assigned storage area.
5. Hairstylist
Cuts and styles men’s and women’s hair after guests have showered and washed hair. Works in the open air, follows current Covid related health protocols. Brings own equipment and disinfecting materials.
6. Restroom monitor
Controls access to restrooms and ensures proper sanitation and ventilation
7. Hospitality table.
Send email to Jan Bluemer (j.bluemer@icloud.com) to coordinate ordering and picking up donated coffee and breakfast snacks. Set up and staff hospitality table at 8 AM.
8. Towel laundry volunteer
Volunteer takes 15–30 soil towels to launder, dry, fold and return before the next Saturday. Picks up towels between 11:30 AM and noon.
